### Responsibilities:

- Using research, experiments, and observation to determine the behavior of a child and the factors which influence it.
- Conducting regular scheduled sessions for children with Down Syndrome.
- Analyzing child's behavioral patterns to diagnose mental health disorders.
- Planning for behavioral and developmental customized sessions.
- Assisting the child in developing healthier thought patterns and behaviors.
- Being able to recognize and respond to critical improvements in child's behaviors.
- Becoming familiar with and use behavioral redirection techniques.
- Knowing how to respond to negative behaviors appropriately.
- Responding and attending to child and/or parent/caregivers' questions and comments.
- Responding to situations in appropriate, fair, and consistent ways, while taking advice and assistance from the supervisor/head of department.
- Giving parents/caregivers clear, accurate, specific, meaningful, and timely feedback to enhance their child's speech and language development.
- Writing and delivering reports to parents/caregivers when needed.
- Preparing and sharing evaluation reports of children in therapy cyclically, or when requested by the program lead.
- Any other task as assigned by the management.

### Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree (Psychology) from an HEC recognized institution.
- Minimum 02 years of relevant work experience is preferred.
- RBT/IBT/IBA certification is mandatory.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, especially report writing skills.
- Strong organizing skills.
- Excellent with networking/building relationships with people.
- Must be an excellent observer and problem solver.
- Must have compassion and patience.
